BACKGROUND

St Anne's is a Church of England VA Primary School just outside Weston-Super-Mare. New homes in the area have dramatically increased the demand for school places and in March 2014 the school set about meeting the demand by building a second site 3 miles away, to run in parallel with the existing school.



DECISION-MAKING

Building a new school while running an existing one has its challenges but the school senior leadership team were determined to get the very best for their new site. The new school building was planned with a light and airy multipurpose hall at its heart.
